- Academic counseling linked to career exploration and encouragement.
- Attend Parent/Teacher Conferences.

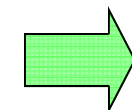

Deepening Impact: Key Elements for Effective Youth Development

Boys & Girls Clubs are charged with deepening their impact on the young people they serve. BGCA identified five key elements of positive youth development.

The level of impact a Club has on young people depends on:

- 1) the frequency of their participation and
- 2) the degree to which the Club implements five key elements in its operations.

1. A Safe, Positive Environment
2. Fun
3. Supportive Relationships
4. Opportunities and Expectations
5. Recognition

When the five key elements are intentionally infused in a Club's programs and operations, the Club **creates a developmentally rich environment that leads to deepening impact.**
